Grades K-2

Grades K-2

Draw a picture of your favorite story about Moses. Why is it your favorite?

Grades 3-5

Why do think that God chose Moses to lead his people? Write about it.

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Journal – E3. Manna and Quail

Grades K-2

What are you most thankful for? Draw pictures of the things you are most thankful for.

Grades 3-5 (choose one)

Have you ever given someone a gift and they didn't say "thank you?" How did that make you feel? If it hasn't happened to you, imagine it did. How do you think you would feel about that person? Write about it.

What are you most thankful for? Today? This week? This month? This year? Write about what you are feeling thankful for in your heart.

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Journal – E4. The Ten Commandments/The Golden Calf

Grades K-2

What commandment is hard for you to follow? Why?

Grades 3-5 (choose one)

Choose one of the 10 Commandments. Write it down in your journal. Then write about what that commandment means to you.

Write down the fourth commandment in your journal. How do you honor your mother and father? What does that mean? Write as many ways as you can think of to bring honor to your parents. Write about it.

Describe what the world would be like with no laws.

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Journal – E5. Cloud and Fire

Grades K-2

What do you think it means to follow Jesus? Draw a picture.

Grades 3-5 (choose one)

Why do you think that you should choose to follow Jesus in your life? Be specific. Write about it.

Pretend you are trying to persuade someone else (maybe a friend) to follow Jesus. What would you tell him/her? Write about it.

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Journal – E6. The Twelve Spies

Grades K-2

How do you think God feels when we grumble and complain (like the Israelites did)? Draw a picture.

Grades 3-5 (choose one)

Think about today's story. What would you tell someone who felt as if they were in a hopeless situation and had nowhere to turn? How would you persuade them to turn to God? Write about it.

Do you believe God can help you handle any fear or problem? Why or why not? Write about it.

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Journal – E7. Moses Disobeys God

Grades K-2

Draw a picture of a time that you made a poor choice. How did you make it right again? Write about it.

Grades 3-5 (choose one)

Think about all of God's commandments. How would your life be different if God was not just and fair? Write about it.

Everyone makes mistakes and once in a while makes a choice that "isn't so good." What could you do when this happens to make things right with God? Write about it.

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Journal – E8. Thanksgiving

Grades K-2

Who is the one person that you are most thankful for in your life? Draw a picture and write about why you are thankful for them.

Grades 3-5 (choose one)

Write a thank you letter to God. Tell Him about all the things that you are thankful for in your heart. Write about it.

Do you think it is important to have a thankful heart? Why or why not? Write about it.

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Journal – E9. Balaam and the Donkey

Grades K-2

Draw a picture showing how you can ask God for help or guidance. Write down one thing you need his help with.

Grades 3-5 (choose one)

Is there anything you are facing in your life (now or in the future) that you need God's guidance in order to help you know what to do? Write about it.

Who other than God do you turn to for guidance in your life? Why do you turn to them? Write about it.

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Journal – E10. Joshua, Rahab and the Spies

Grades K-2

Draw a large heart on your paper. Then draw pictures (or write) what things you think you should have inside your heart.

Grades 3-5 (choose one)

If God could look into your heart today, what do you think he would see? Write about it.

When was the last time you helped someone in need? How did it make you feel? Write about it.

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Journal – E11. Crossing the Jordan River

Grades K-2

Draw a picture of what you think faith looks like.

Grades 3-5 (choose one)

How big is your faith in God? We know that Jesus was born and died on the cross. But do you believe with your whole heart that Jesus is going to return to the earth again on the day of the Lord? Why do you believe it? Write about it.

Why do you think it is important to be obedient to your parents? Write about it.

Grades K-2
